Who You Gonna Call?

In Matthew 6:9 Jesus tells us who to call in His command to keep on praying: "Pray, then, in this way: "Our Father who is in heaven..."

Three Facts About Praying to Our Father in Heaven

1. Our Heart Cry to the Father Is Often <u>DEFECTIVE</u>.

Our Thoughts of God the Father Are Often...

- Dysfunctional due to our fallen FATHERS.
- > Distorted due to our *fallen* <u>CULTURE</u>.
- > Depraved due to our **fallen NATURE**.

2. Our Heart Cry to the Father Can Be <u>DIFFERENT!</u>

The Triune God Makes the Difference

> The Son **INVITES** us to pray to God as "our Father."

"Pray, then, in this way, "Our Father who is in heaven"

1. First, Jesus must **INTRODUCE** us to God as a Father.

Birthright of Children by the Shed Blood of the Son. John 1:12-13

Legal Right of Sons by the Sovereign Choice of the Father with the Indwelling Spirit. Ephesians 1:4-5; Galatians 3:26; 4:6-7

2. Then Jesus **INVITES** us to address God as "our Father" in prayer.

Old Testament Way of Addressing God

Jesus' Unique Way of Addressing God

The Heart Cry of the Son to the Father Like **NO ONE** before Him!

The Spirit <u>INDWELLS</u> us to cry out: "Dearest Father!"

Jesus' heart cry was "ABBA Father"! Mark 14:36 "The Father of All Fathers Is Now My Father and Our Father!"

Our heart cry is the **SAME**: "Abba Father"!

1. This cry is a **GIFT** from the Father to us. Galatians 4:6

2. This cry is a **WITNESS** of the Spirit in us. Romans 8:15-16

"A sign of spiritual health and authentic faith!" - R. Kent Hughes

3. This cry is the **HEART CRY** of the Son by us. *Galatians 4:7; Romans 8:15*

A Cry from the Heart to God

BE for us what no one else can be in our lives: Our Dearest Heavenly Father!

DO for us what we cannot do for ourselves: Live like Your Holy Children!

The Father <u>INTERVENES</u> for us from heaven.

What Does "in Heaven" Mean?

- 1. Our Father is *profoundly MYSTERIOUS* like no other. *Matthew 23*:9
- 2. Our Father is perfectly MAJESTIC like no other. Matthew 5:48; Ecclesiastes 5:2
- 3. Our Father is powerfully MIGHTY like no other. Psalm 119:89; 135:5-6

He **provides** for us **better** than any father ever could. *Matthew 7:9-11*He **pardons** us **quicker** than any father ever would. *Luke 15:18-24*He **protects** us **longer** and **stronger** than any father ever could. *Romans 8:31-39*

3. Our Heart Cry to the Father Should Be <u>DYNAMIC!</u>

Praying to Our Father Who Is in Heaven Should...

Change the way we THINK.

Self-Centered Thinking Can Be Replaced with...

God-centered thinking and other-centered thinking.

Change the way we <u>LIVE</u>.

I am free to *give* to others because I have a Father who is has promised to *provide* for me.

I am free to *forgive* others because I have a Father who is quick to *pardon* me. Luke 23:34

I am free to *live* for God and others because I have a Father who is strong to *protect* me from the world, the flesh, and the devil! *Matthew 26:42; John 12:27-28; John 17:1-6*

Change the way we PRAY.

God Is Our FATHER! Come to Him with Child-like Boldness!

God Is Our DEAREST Father! Cry Out to Him with Heart-felt Tenderness!

God Is Our HEAVENLY Father! Count on Him for Life-changing Holiness!
