Lesson Five • John 8:1-11

The Woman Caught in Adultery

A Sinful Woman Encounters the Savior

We see the GRACE and TRUTH of Jesus when a woman is caught in adultery but not condemned.

And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we have seen His glory, glory as of the only Son from the Father, full of grace and truth. John 1:14

For the law was given through Moses; grace and truth came through Jesus Christ. John 1:17

A Woman Caught But Not Condemned

1. Grace and Truth Is Ruthlessly IGNORED by the Religious Leaders!

A Trap Laid

- The religious leaders misused the WOMAN in their indignation of Jesus (vs. 3-4).
- The religious leaders misused the LAW in their motivation to trap Jesus (vs. 5-6).

2. Grace and Truth Is Justly REVEALED by Jesus!

A Challenge Made

- Jesus IGNORED His accusers (vs. 6-8).
- Jesus EXPOSED His accusers (vs. 9).

3. Grace and Truth Is Lovingly OFFERED to the Woman!

A Pardon Given

- Jesus FORGAVE the woman of her sin (vs. 10-11).
- Jesus FREED the woman to sin no more (vs. 11).

Caught in Sin

All of us are like this woman: we are guilty of SIN and deserve condemnation.

Saved by the Savior

On what basis can Jesus say, "Neither do I condemn you" when we are guilty of sin?

The answer is the CROSS, on which Jesus died for our sins and satisfied the justice of God.

For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but in order that the world might be saved through Him. John 3:17

There is therefore now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus. Romans 8:1
