The Bible Is the Story of God's Glory!

The Bible Is the One Story of God's Glory Progressively Revealed on Earth as It Is in Heaven!

- ➤ The Bible is **ONE STORY**.
- The Bible is the one story of GOD'S GLORY.
- The Bible is the one story of His glory PROGRESSIVELY revealed on earth as it is in heaven.

Approach Your Bible in a Way that Keeps the Big Picture in View

Two Heart Postures to Keep the Story of His Glory Before You!

1. Approach Your Bible CANONICALLY. Read the ENTIRE Bible Repeatedly!

- **Canon =** The "standard" or "rule" (the measuring stick/ruler) for the faith once delivered to the saints by God Himself through human authors in the inspired Scriptures (= Writings), which His people have recognized as being revealed by Him.
- > Don't **UNHITCH** from the Old Testament.
- Don't <u>OVERSTAY</u> in the New Testament.
- > Don't **PIT** one part of the Bible against another.
 - Don't pit the **OT** against the **NT**.
 - Don't pit the wrath of the God in the OT against the love of Jesus in the NT.
 - Don't pit Paul's emphasis on faith against James emphasis on works.
 - Don't pit Luke's emphasis on repentance and faith against John's use of believing.
 - Don't pit Jesus in the Gospels against Jesus in the Book of Revelation.

Yes, but How?

- Read your whole Bible like you WASH YOUR HAIR!
- Read the Bible in BIG CHUNKS in 90 days or ONE BOOK for 30 days.

2. Approach Your Bible PROGRESSIVELY. Read to See How God's KINGDOM Story Is Fulfilled!

Progressive = The Bible is revealed in various stages (ages/epochs/administrations/dispensations) that build upon one another and eventually climax in God's coming Kingdom: "Your Kingdom come Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven!"

God's Kingdom Plan for Creation GOD'S GLORIOUS PRESENCE Progressively Rules with GOD'S PEOPLE over GOD'S PLACE through GOD'S PERSON by GOD'S POWER for GOD'S PURPOSE!

The Progressive Revelation of the Mediatorial Kingdom

The Eternal Kingdom of God: The Triune God is the eternal King who always rules over all. Psalm 145:10-13; Jeremiah 10:10; 1Timothy 1:17; 6:16; Jude 25

The Mediatorial Kingdom of God: The Triune God chooses to rule on earth as He does in heaven through His Image-Bearers. Genesis 1:26-28; Daniel 2:44; 7:27; Matthew 6:10; Acts 1:6; Hebrews 2:8; Colossians 1:13; Revelation 2:26-27; 3:21; 11:15; 1 Corinthians 15:20-28

1. The KINGDOM **PATTERN** in Creation. Genesis 1-2

Creation Plan Reveals the Kingdom Pattern: God's presence ruling with God's people over God's place.

Image Bearers: Kingdom-Mediators are Glory-Mirrors with a unique Relationship to God, Representation of God, and Rule Under God.

2. The KINGDOM **PERVERTED** by the Depravity of Humanity. *Genesis 3 – 11*

The **FALL** of Adam & Eve who believe the lie and rebel to be like gods.

Redemption Promised: The LORD promises the Seed of the Woman will be the Head-Crusher that conquers the Heel-Biter!

The **FRICTION** between Cain & Abel over acceptable worship – People Begin to Call on the Name of the LORD.

The **FLOOD** of Depravity in Noah's Day – The Sons of God Boast in Their Sexuality, Violence, and Language Like Little Gods.

The **FUTILITY** of Tower Building – Humanity Rebels as City-Gathers and Tower-Builders to Make a Name for Themselves.

Noahic Covenant: The LORD covenants with creation to preserve it until His creation plan, redemption promise, & kingdom pattern are fulfilled.

3. The KINGDOM **PROMISED** to Israel's Patriarchs. *Genesis* 12 –50

Abrahamic Covenant: The LORD covenants with Abraham & his seed by grace thru faith to be a blessing to the nations as a kingdom people.

4. The KINGDOM **PURSUED** with the Nation of Israel. Exodus – Ruth

Mosaic Covenant: The LORD covenants with Israel to be a royal priesthood to the nations in the Promised Land with blessing and cursing.

The KINGDOM <u>PICTURED</u> in the Kingdom of Israel. 1Samuel – 2Chronicles; Psalms – Song of Songs

Davidic Covenant: The LORD covenants with David and his sons to rule as kings over His kingdom people.

The KINGDOM PUNISHED-PRESERVED with Exile and Captivity. 2Kings; Ezra – Esther

Covenant Loyalty: The LORD remains loyal to His covenant promises and His covenant people with loving-kindness and gracious faithfulness.

The KINGDOM **PREDICTED** in Israel's Coming King. *Isaiah–Malachi*

Covenant Enforcers: The LORD sends His Servants the Prophets to predict comfort for the Loyal Remnant and condemnation for the Disloyal. New Covenant Promised: The LORD promises to establish a New Covenant with Israel to create a Loyal Heart by the Indwelling Spirit of God. Coming King Predicted: The Coming King is a Suffering Servant and Sovereign Savior who restores Israel and is a Light to the Nations.

400 YEARS of SILENCE

Israel SUFFERS Under the Gentile Kingdoms of Babylon, Greece, Medio-Persia, and Rome.

Israel STRUGGLES to Maintain Faith, Hope, and Love as They Wait for the Coming of the King.

Israel STRIVES to Fulfill the Promise in the Power of the Flesh:

Separatism of the Essenes, Rationalism of the Sadducees, Legalism of the Pharisees, Radicalism of the Zealots

- 5. The KINGDOM <u>PRESENT</u> in the King's 1st Coming: The Kingdom is near because the King is here! The Gospels

 Israel Rejects Her King: Partial hardening of Israel begins as the mystery of the Kingdom and Church unfolds to bring salvation to the nations.

 New Covenant Established: The LORD meets the conditions of the covenants and will partially fulfill them in the Mystery of the Church.
- 6. The KINGDOM <u>PROCLAIMED</u> by the King's Church: Called Out Subjects in Kingdom Outposts on mission! Acts, Epistles, Revelation 1-3

 Now-Not Yet Mystery: Partial Kingdom fulfillment in the Church during the partial hardening of Israel until full number of Gentiles are saved.
- 7. The KINGDOM <u>PREVAILS</u> in the King's 2nd Coming: The Kingdom on earth as it is in heaven! Revelation 4-20

 Covenant Fulfillment: The King fulfills all the covenant promises to Israel and the Church on the Day of the LORD (Tribulation and Kingdom)!
- 8. The KINGDOM **PERFECTED** When the King Rules Over All: *God is all in all!* Revelation 21 22; 1 Corinthians 15:20-28

New Creation Glory: The King subjects Himself and His Kingdom to the Father, so that God is all in all as the progression of the creation plan, redemption promise, and kingdom pattern is completely fulfilled.

Approach Your Bible to Not Only See the Big Picture but Also the Big Person Who Fulfills the Big Plan!
