Lesson 6

Holy and Loving at the Same Time?

Exodus 15:22-34:35

Can God be holy and loving at the same time? Can He be loving and remain holy? And if so, is He?

How Should We Respond to God When He Reveals Himself as "I AM" Holy?

By Singing the Song of MOSES (Exodus 15:1-21) and the Song of the LAMB (Revelation 15:3-4)!

Live like a people who have been rescued to be on mission with the I AM God...

- **PRAISE** His HOLY Name
- **PROCLAIM** His HOLY Name
- PRACTICE His HOLY Name

How Did His Rescued People Respond in the Wilderness?

The Rescued Responded with UNGRATEFUL GRIPING. Exodus 15:22–18:27 1.

► Griping about no water (15:22-27) Griping about no food (15:22-27)

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IN LOVE, the I AM God provides fresh water from bitter! IN LOVE, the I AM God provides bread from heaven! IN LOVE, the I AM God provides water from rock!

Griping about no water again (15:22-27)

IN LOVE, the I AM God goes the extra mile and...

- Gives victory over a Gentile king that *resists* them. (17:8-16)
- Gives salvation to a Gentile priest who accepts the I AM God as the one true God. (18:1-27)

How Did the "I AM" God of Love Respond?

The "I AM" God reveals the glory of His HOLY NAME on Mount Sinai. Exodus 19:1-25 1.

IN LOVE, the I AM God keeps His promise to Moses at the Burning Bush!

IN LOVE, the I AM God reveals the GLORY of His holy name to the Israelites He has rescued out of Egypt-even though they have been ungrateful gripers ever since their rescue from Égypt!

- 2. The "I AM" God reveals His HOLY LAW and LOVING DESIRE to dwell with His people to Moses. Exodus 20:1-31:18
 - The Law (the "Big Ten" plus more) is revealed. Exodus 20:1–23:33

IN LOVE, the I AM God expects them to be holy as He is holy so He reveals His holy Law to them!

The Mosaic Covenant is ratified between the I AM God and His people, Israel. Exodus 24:1-18

IN LOVE, the I AM God desires to dwell with His people and have fellowship with them. (1-2)

IN LOVE, the I AM God desires to be in a covenant relationship of loving obedience with His people. (3-4)

The Plans for the Tabernacle Revealed - Exodus 25:1–31:18

How Did His Rescued People Respond?

- 1. The Rescued literally **BREAK** every law and boldly **DEFAME** His Holy Name. Exodus 32:1–6
- 2. The I AM God is JEALOUS for the fame of His Holy Name! Exodus 32:7-8; 20:5-6

IN LOVE, the "I AM" God will not let anyone or anything defame His Name or diminish His glory for He alone is God and only He can meet the needs of His people and to do otherwise would be untrue, unfaithful, and unloving.

How Did the "I AM" God of Love and His Mediator Moses Respond?

1. The "I AM" God tests the HOLY LOVE of His Mediator, Moses. Exodus 32:9–32

IN LOVE, the I AM God tests Moses to see if he will love God's people like God has loved him! Will he love the rebellious and sinful people with a HOLY LOVE like the I AM God does?! (32:9-10)

- > Moses *intercedes* for the people with the same kind of love God has had for him. (11-14)
- Moses carries out God's holy judgment. (15-29)
- Moses intercedes again for the people and seeks atonement for their sin from God. (30-32)

IN LOVE, Moses passes the test to see if he loves God's people like God has loved him! Moses loves the rebellious and sinful people with a **HOLY** and **SELF-SACRIFICING LOVE** just like the I AM God does!

2. The "I AM" God responds with HOLY LOVE for His people. Exodus 32:33-35

IN LOVE, the "I AM" God makes clear to Moses that he can't be the much-needed Substitute to atone for the sinning people, because only the "I AM" God is the sovereign Judge who executes judgment and could ever atone for sin.

How Did His Rescued People Respond?

 The Rescued people finally <u>REPENT</u> at the thought of God's holy presence no longer dwelling with them. Exodus 33:1-6

IN LOVE, the I AM God tests Israel to see if they are willing to live WITHOUT His holy presence dwelling with them!

 Moses once again intercedes for the sinful people, so God's glory would <u>REMAIN</u> with Israel and be <u>REVEALED</u> to Moses. Exodus 33:7-23
