Reviewing Your Kingdom Come

➤ How Does This **PETITION RELATE** to the First?

“Your Kingdom come” is the **ultimate way** His name will be made holy in all the earth and the **ultimate pursuit** of everyone who’s priority is the fame of His Name.

➤ What Are the Four **IMPLICATIONS** of His Kingdom Coming?

1) Implications for God’s Program.

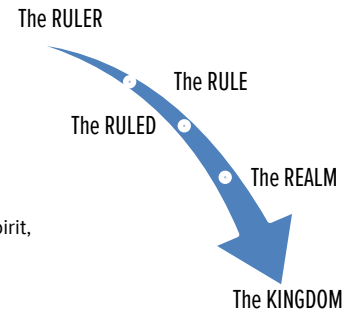
*God’s program for making His name holy on earth as it is heaven is the coming of His **KINGDOM!***

How Will God Cause It to Come?

God’s **ETERNAL** Kingdom in Heaven reveals a **PROMISED** Kingdom on Earth that becomes the **COMING** Kingdom on Earth as it is in Heaven.

The Father does this through His Son (the promised God-Man, the Lord Jesus Christ) and by His Spirit, so that God’s Presence rules with God’s people over God’s Place through God’s Person by God’s Power for God’s Purpose.

1Corinthians 15:22-28



2) Implications for **Biblical Prophecy**

“Your Kingdom Come” Is a Declaration.

*We live in the “Now-Not Yet” of the kingdom: The King has **already** come but His kingdom has **not yet** come on earth as it is in heaven!*

3) Implications for **Daily Prayer**

“Your Kingdom Come” Is Not Just a Declaration It’s Also a Petition.

Our prayers advance God’s kingdom program and fulfill biblical prophecy. Revelation 5:8-10; 6:9-11; 8:1-6

4) Implications for **Daily Pursuits**

“Your Kingdom Come” Is Not Just a Petition; It’s Also a Dedication.

“For the kingdom of God to come means that all other kingdoms (including our own!) must fade into oblivion.” – R. Albert Mohler, Jr.

Six Proofs the Coming Kingdom Is Our Greatest Pursuit

1. We Are **PREPARING** with Kingdom Readiness.

➤ The King’s coming will be soon, sudden, and sure. *Matthew 24:36–25:30*

Those who are truly ready for the kingdom to come are waiting, watching and working!

2. We Are PRACTICING Kingdom Repentance.

- Keep REPENTING until the kingdom comes.

John the Baptist: Matthew 3:2; Jesus: 4:17; Peter: Acts 2:38; 3:19; 8:22; Paul: 17:30

Repentance: A God-given change of HEART that leads to a change of LIFE!

- Keep BEARING fruit of repentance until the kingdom comes. *Matthew 21:28-32, 43*

John the Baptist: Matthew 3:7-10; Jesus: Matthew 7:15-21; 21:28-32, 43; Paul: Acts 26:20

3. We Are PRIORITIZING Kingdom Living Here and Now.

Matthew 6:33; 5:19-20

4. We Are PROCLAIMING Kingdom News to All People Groups.

Matthew 28:18-20; Luke 4:43; Matthew 24:14; Acts 28:28-31

"The kingdom comes mainly through proclamation, through the announcement that Christ, who was crucified, is now King....The only way people ever come into God's kingdom is by hearing His heralds proclaim a crucified King."— Philip Ryken

Proclaim the Good News across the street and around the world: "The King has come and is coming again!"

5. We Are PERSEVERING with Kingdom Hope through Suffering.

2Corinthians 4:7-18; Romans 8:14-25; Acts 14:22; 1Thessalonians 1:9-10

6. We Are PRAYING to the Father by the Spirit for the Son to Come and Claim His Kingdom Realm.
