Truth Matters... So Look Out for the Truth! Part 2

Lesson 8 • 2 John 10-11

How Do God's Elect People Look Out for the Truth? By Protecting One Another from False <u>TEACHING</u> (7-9) and False <u>TEACHERS</u> (10-11).

Two Warnings About Rejecting False Teachers

1. <u>ANYONE</u> can be a false teacher!

- ANYONE who goes too far and does not <u>ABIDE</u> in the teaching of Christ. (v. 9)
 - 1) Teaching FROM Christ and his apostles. (1John 4:1-6)
 - 2) Teaching ABOUT Christ and the gospel. (1John 2:18-25)
- ANYONE who comes to you and does not <u>BRING</u> this teaching, do not receive him into your house, and do not give him a greeting. (v. 10)

2. Not EVERYONE who teaches error is a false teacher!

- Learn to discern the differences in the <u>DEGREES</u> of error. (See Chart)
- ► Learn to develop your <u>UNDERSTANDING</u> of gospel essentials and sound doctrine. (1Timothy 6:3)
 - 1) Just because someone *disagrees* with you does not make them a false teacher.
 - 2) Just because someone teaches something you were *never* taught or were *always* taught was wrong, does not make what they are teaching false or them a false teacher.

Three Ways We as God's Elect People Protect One Another from False Teachers

1. <u>RESIST</u> their false teaching.

"Watch yourselves, that you do not lose what we have accomplished, but that you may receive a full reward. Anyone who goes too far and does not abide in the teaching of Christ, does not have God; the one who abides in the teaching, he has both the Father and the Son." 2John 8-9

<u>RESIST</u> the temptation to go beyond the teaching *from* and *about* Jesus Christ in search of salvation, sanctification, and future glorification.

REMAIN within the bounds of the teaching *from* and *about* Jesus Christ in both your belief and behavior.

2. <u>**REJECT**</u> the false teacher.

"If anyone comes to you and does not bring this teaching, do not receive them into your house, and do not give them a greeting." 2John 10

Three Aspects to This Kind of Rejection

- Refuse to <u>ACCEPT</u> them into the Church-Home.
 "do not receive them into your house"
- Refuse to <u>ASSIST</u> them in their ministry. "do not receive them...and do not give them a greeting."
- Refuse to <u>ACKNOWLEDGE</u> them as members in God's family.
 "do not give them a greeting."

Do not recognize the unbelieving as believers, Do not acknowledge as family those who refuse to acknowledge the Father and His Son according to the essentials of the gospel!

- 1) Paul recognized different levels of fellowship, separation, and rejection. 2Thessalonians 3:14-15; 1Corinthians 5:9-11
- 2) Jesus Himself taught us to judge false teachers by their fruit. Matthew 7:12-23
- 3) We should always seek to *love in the truth* and *according to the truth*, but *never ever at the expense of the truth*. 2John 1-6; Jude 17-25

3. <u>REMEMBER</u> what's at stake when it comes to false teachers and their teaching.

"for the one who gives him a greeting participates in his evil deeds." 2John 11

What's at Stake When It Comes to Protecting One Another from False Teachers and Their False Teaching?

- Rewards are LOST by true believers and churches who fail to resist false teaching. (v. 8)
- Salvation is <u>MISSED</u> by *anyone* who goes *beyond* the bounds of the gospel and *fails* to abide in the teachings of Christ. (v. 9)
- Evil is <u>PROMOTED</u> by anyone who welcomes false teachers as true teachers and partners in spreading their false teaching. (v. 11; 3John 5-8)

BE INHOSPITABLE to ERROR by REJECTING FALSE TEACHERS!

RESIST their false teaching, **REJECT** them by **REFUSING** to help them spread their influence and promote their ministry, and always **REMEMBER** what's at stake!
