The Reason the Savior Was Born

Jesus came to REDEEM those under the law.

But when the fullness of time had come, God sent forth His Son, born of a woman, born under the law, to redeem those who were under the law... Galatians 4:4-5

Everything about Jesus' Coming Was Perfect

1. Jesus Came at the Perfect TIME.

The World When Christ Was Born

- Politically, it was a time of Roman PEACE.
- Culturally, it was a time of common LANGUAGE.
- Spiritually, it was a time of religious BANKRUPTCY.

2. Jesus Came in the Perfect MANNER.

But when the fullness of the time had come, God sent forth His Son, born of a woman, born under the law. Galatians 4:4

In the Incarnation

God perfectly declared His love for us by SENDING His Son:
fully divine, fully human, and fully righteous.

3. Jesus Came for the Perfect REASON.

To redeem those who were under the law, that we might receive the adoption as sons. And because you are sons, God has sent forth the Spirit of His Son into your hearts, crying out, "Abba, Father!" Therefore you are no longer a slave but a son, and if a son, then an heir of God through Christ. Galatians 4:5-7

The Reason Jesus Came

- Jesus came that we might experience REDEMPTION from sin.
- Jesus came that we might receive ADOPTION as sons.

A Most Important Question

Have you experienced the reason for Jesus' coming?

Have you been redeemed from your sin and adopted as a son into God's eternal family through faith in Jesus Christ?

To redeem those who were under the law, that we might receive the adoption as sons. Galatians 4:5
