The Beauty of Unity

1. True Christian Unity Comes from GOD!

May the God of endurance and encouragement grant you to live in such harmony with one another... Romans 15:5

2. True Christian Unity Is Based on <u>JESUS!</u>

May the God of endurance and encouragement grant you to live in such harmony with one another, in accord with Christ Jesus, Romans 15:5

3. True Christian Unity Results in GLORY to God!

that together you may with one voice glorify the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ. Romans 15:6

4. True Christian Unity WELCOMES One Another!

Therefore welcome one another as Christ has welcomed you, for the glory of God. Romans 15:7

For I tell you that Christ became a servant to the circumcised to show God's truthfulness, in order to confirm the promises given to the patriarchs, and in order that the Gentiles might glorify God for his mercy. Romans 15:8-9a

Giving Thanks for Jesus' Work on the Cross

You may take the bread and cup back to your seat to eat and drink. The bread and juice represent the body and blood of Jesus when He died on the Cross and reminds us who our Lord is, what He has done for us, is doing for us, and will yet do for us when He returns.
